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Figure Title: Supplementary Figure 1. Description of the main steps of the experimental workflow.

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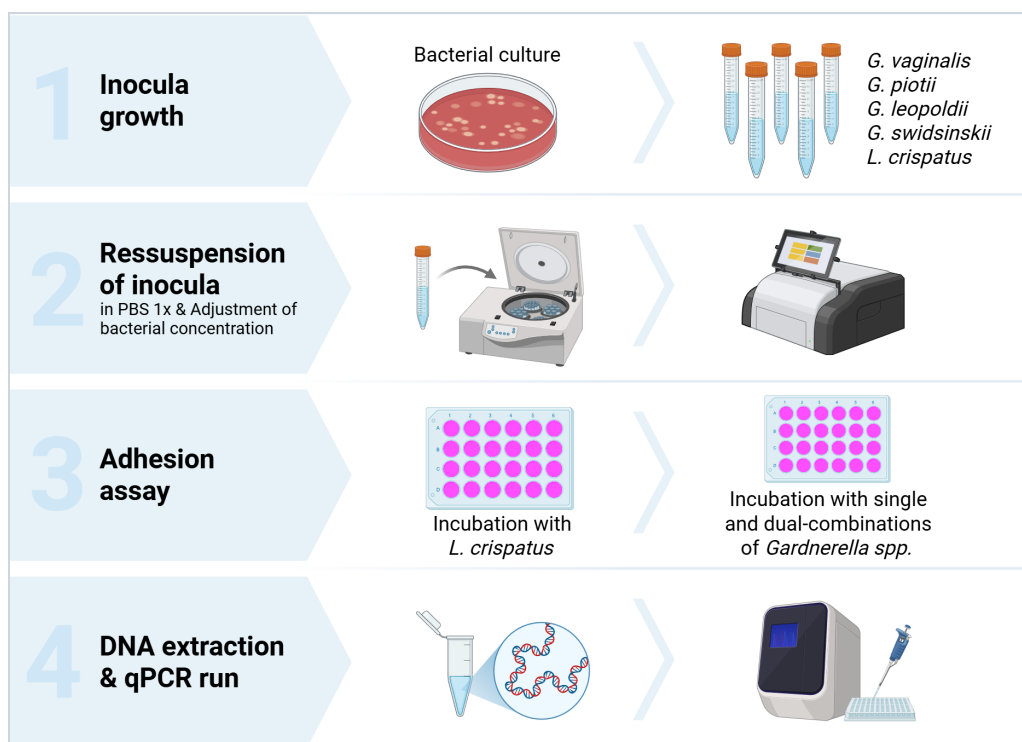
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
