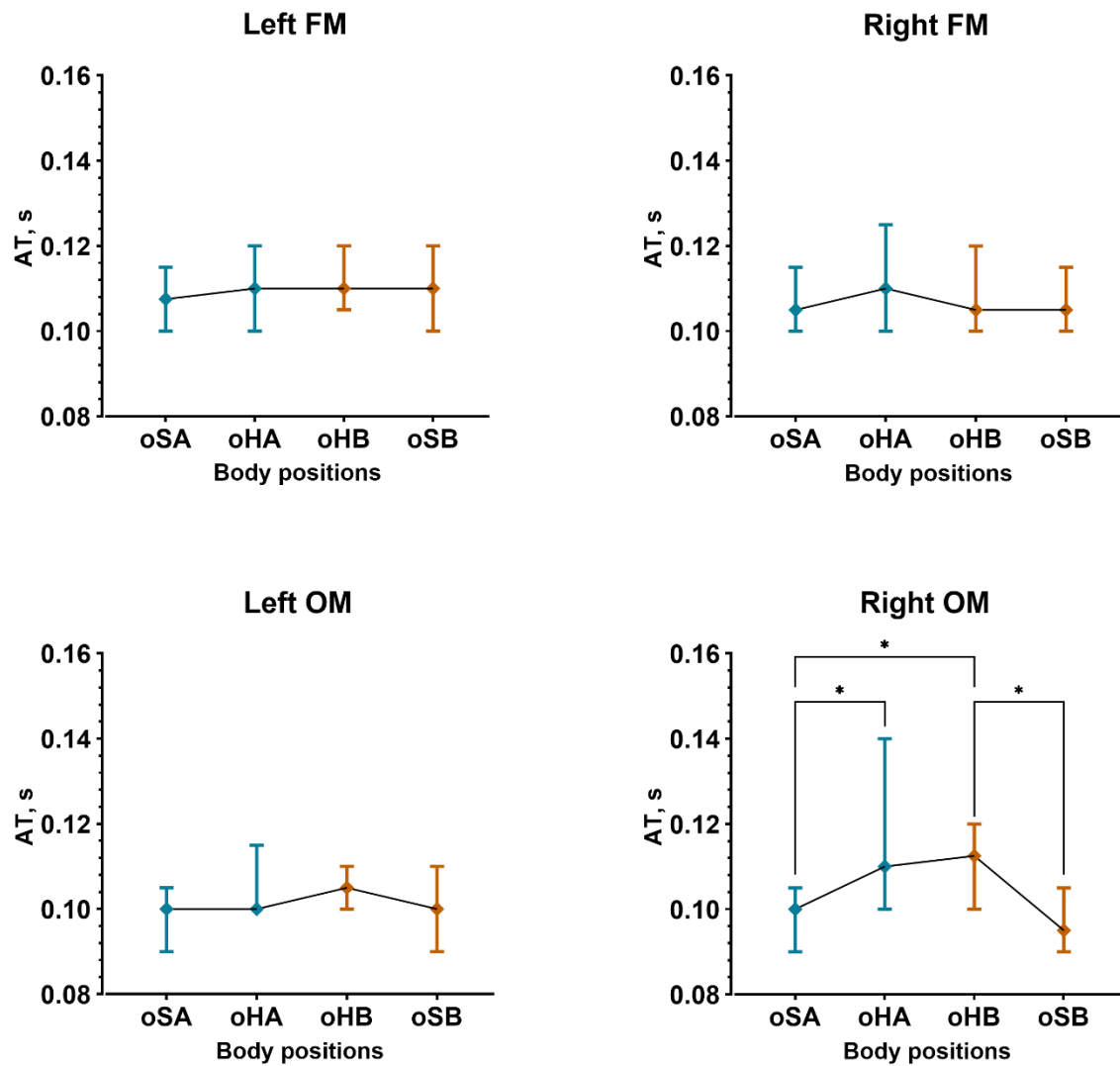




Supplemental Figure 23. Postural changes of AT among male participants during Test 2 (n = 16). The graphs show data from 4 REG leads: left and right fronto-mastoid (FM), left and right occipito-mastoid (OM) for sitting and supine positions. The graphs show confidence intervals with medians depicted as rhomb-shaped points. Additionally, points and intervals are highlighted by different colors to distinguish between first sitting (oSA) and supine (oHA) positions and second sitting (oSB) and supine (oHB) positions. A nonparametric Friedman test summary for statistically significant results: right OM (*Friedman statistic* = 17.31, $p = 0.0006$). “*” – $p < 0.05$.
