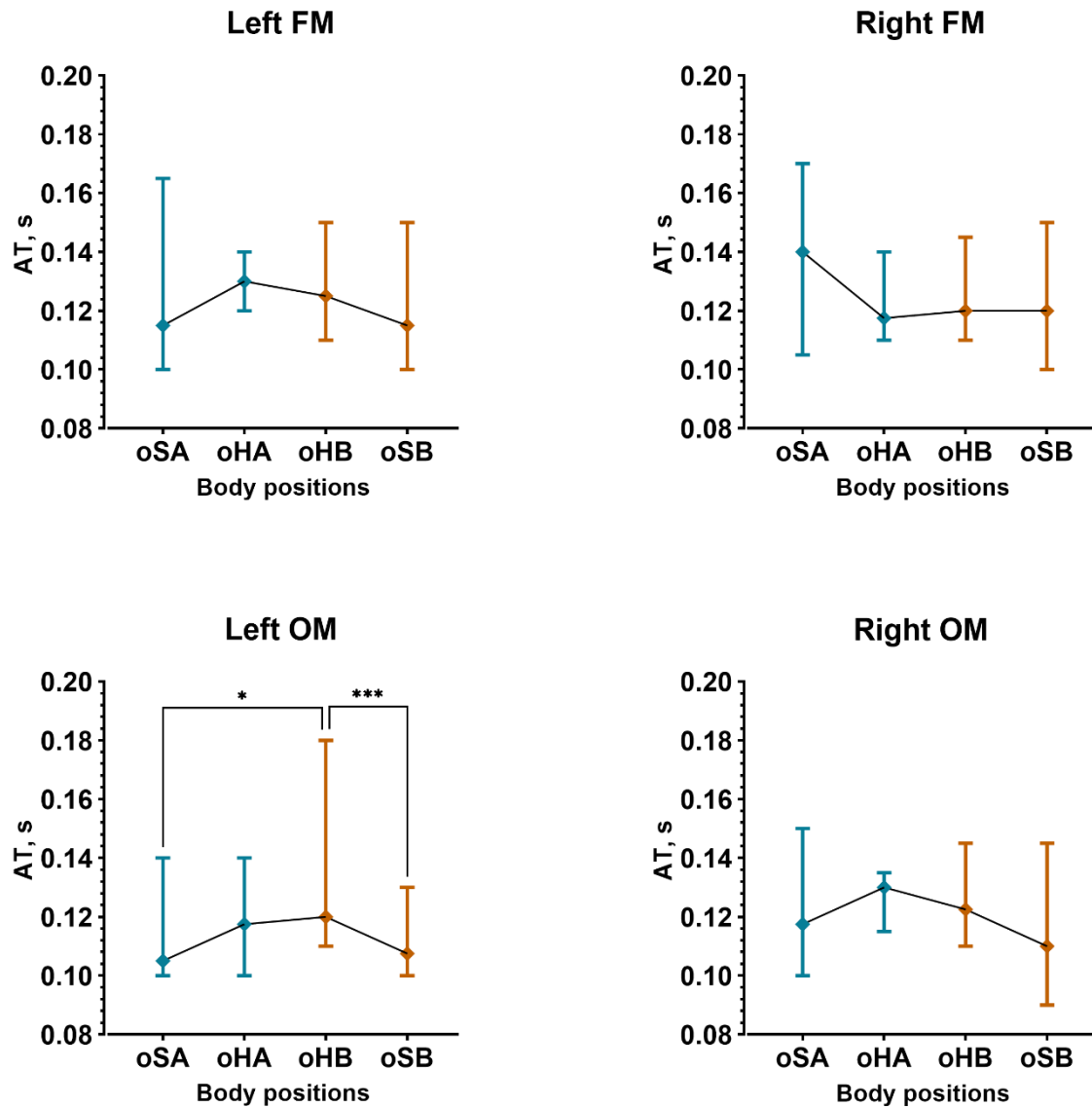




Supplemental Figure 24. Postural changes of AT among female participants during Test 2 (n = 16). The graphs show data from 4 REG leads: left and right fronto-mastoid (FM), left and right occipito-mastoid (OM) for sitting and supine positions. The graphs show confidence intervals with medians depicted as rhomb-shaped points. Additionally, points and intervals are highlighted by different colors to distinguish between first sitting (oSA) and supine (oHA) positions and second sitting (oSB) and supine (oHB) positions. A nonparametric Friedman test summary for statistically significant results: left OM (*Friedman statistic* = 22.05, $p < 0.0001$). “*” – $p < 0.05$, “***” – $p < 0.001$.
