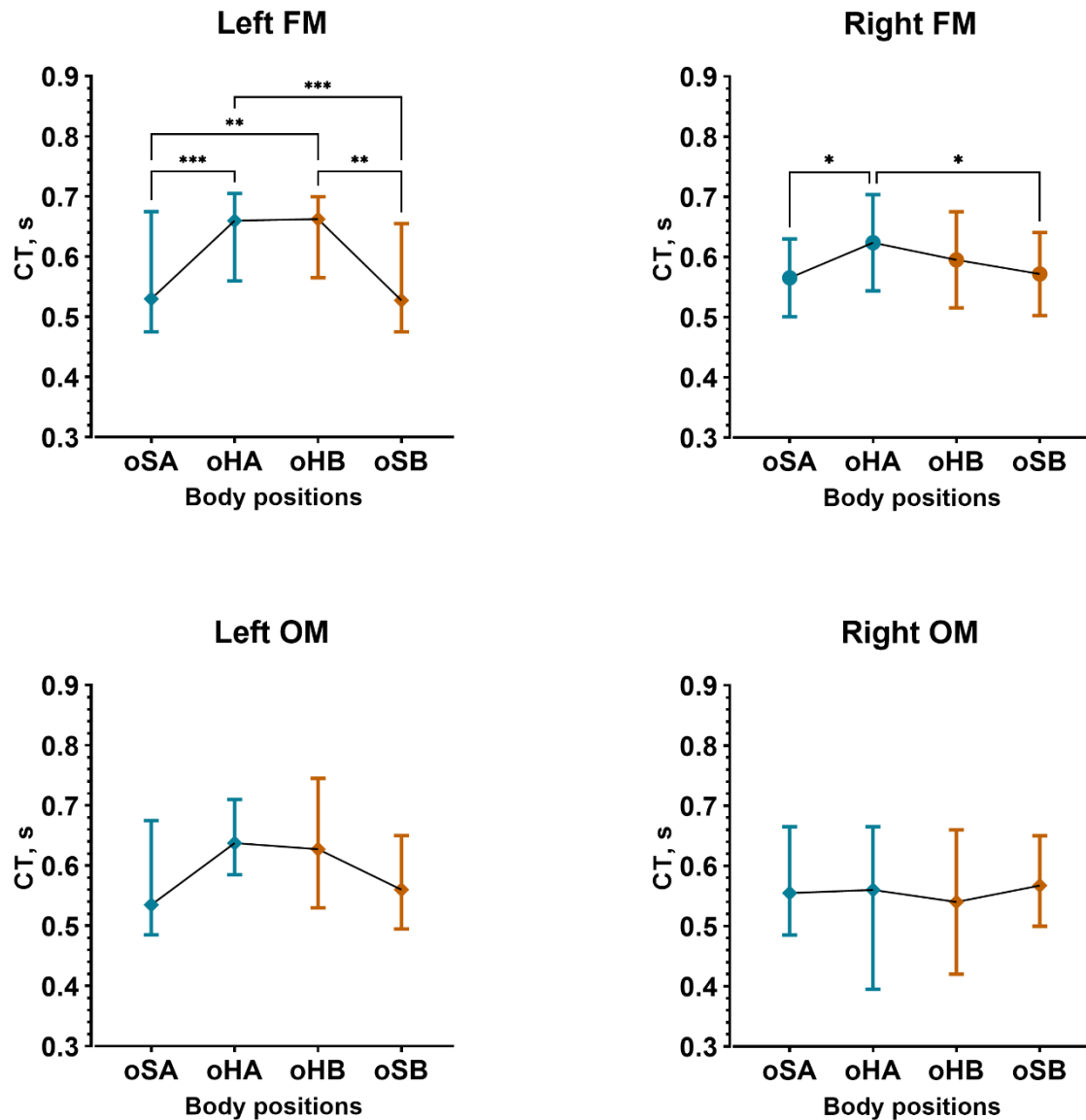




Supplemental Figure 29. Postural changes of CT among female participants during Test 2 (n = 16). The graphs show data from 4 REG leads: left and right fronto-mastoid (FM), left and right occipito-mastoid (OM) for sitting and supine positions. The graphs show confidence intervals with means represented by circle-shaped points, and medians depicted as rhomb-shaped points. Additionally, points and intervals are highlighted by different colors to distinguish between first sitting (oSA) and supine (oHA) positions and second sitting (oSB) and supine (oHB) positions. A one-way repeated measures ANOVA and a nonparametric Friedman test summaries for statistically significant results: left FM (*Friedman statistic* = 27.95, $p < 0.0001$), right FM ($F(1.969, 29.54) = 4.443$, $p = 0.021$). “*” – $p < 0.05$, “**” – $p < 0.01$, “***” – $p < 0.001$.
