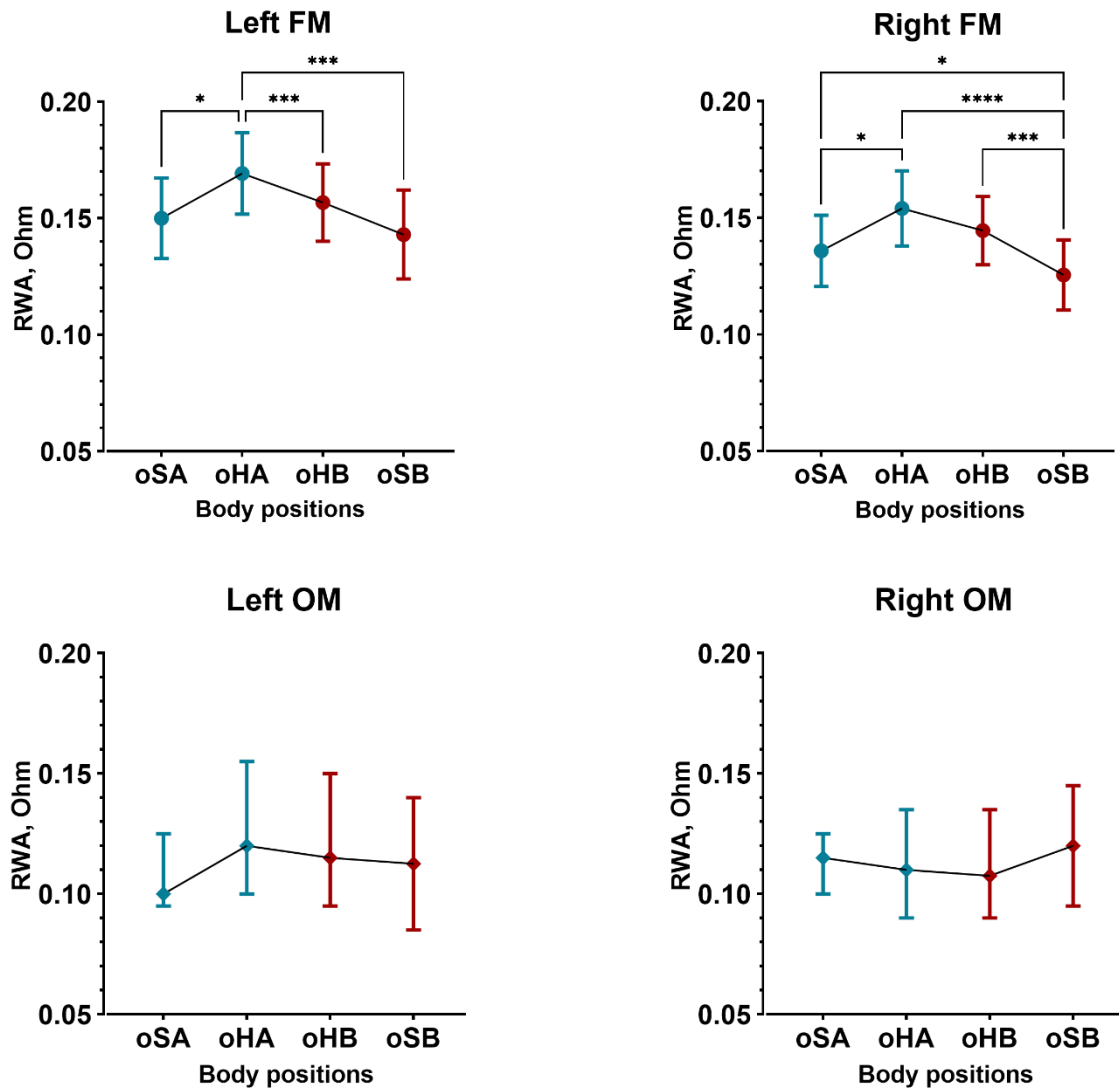




Supplemental Figure 7. Postural changes of RWA among all participants during Test 2 (n = 32). The graphs show data from 4 REG leads: left and right fronto-mastoid (FM), left and right occipito-mastoid (OM) for sitting and supine positions. The graphs show confidence intervals with means represented by circle-shaped points, and medians depicted as rhomb-shaped points. Additionally, points and intervals are highlighted by different colors to distinguish between first sitting (oSA) and supine (oHA) positions and second sitting (oSB) and supine (oHB) positions. A one-way repeated measures ANOVA summary for statistically significant results: left FM ($F(1.949, 60.42) = 8.408, p = 0.0007$), right FM ($F(2.101, 60.92) = 15.55, p < 0.0001$). “*” – $p < 0.05$, “***” – $p < 0.001$, “****” – $p < 0.0001$.
