- Which kind of DAOs were they? What was the main mission? (financial/not financial)
- What's your main motivation for participating in DAOs?
- Is your DAO still active? If not, what happened?
- How often do/did you participate?
- How much activity takes place in your DAO?

Block 2. DAOs community

- Who are the subjects who participate and enter the community?
- Which requirements are necessary to access a DAO? (e.g. owning a token...)
- Who are the most active participants and who are the less active?
- Where does communication take place for discussing DAO's activities? (Online channels, e.g. Telegram/Discord; Offline activities, reunions...)
- Which DAO activity does not happen inside DAOstack?

Block 3. Voting & participating in a DAO?

- How does voting work? (it's decided before and outside the DAO...?)
- Who votes and how often?
- Who are the users who hold more tokens?
- How many people participate in a typical vote?
- In your personal experience, have you regularly voted and/or made a proposal?
- It is common that a few people have much more voting power than most, have you experienced that? How do you feel about it?
- How is staking used?

- Do you think that Holographic Consensus work? Describe it.
- Are you satisfied with your experience with HC? How many times have you used it?
- For which votations is it useful? for which ones it isn't?
- Have you experienced other voting models for DAOs? How do you compare them with HC?
